Material: Vinyl-type mixture

Color: Off white

Coverage: 100 lb. (45.5 kg) to 150 lb. (68 kg) of joint compound per 1000 square feet (92.9 m2) of

wallboard depending upon the thickness of joint compound applied. Shelf Life: 12 months from production code date when stored properly.

Installation

FINISHING JOINTS:

For best results, apply three layers. After each layer is dry, sand or sponge it smooth prior to the application of the subsequent coat.

Begin by applying a thin layer of compound product to the tapered edge. Press joint tape firmly into the compound, placing it centered over the seam and embed with a broad knife. Ensure that sufficient joint compound remains under the tape to guarantee a proper bond. After it has fully dried, apply a second coat of compound over the first coat and feather out past the first coat. Allow the second coat to thoroughly dry. Evenly spread the final coat over the second coat and feather to



form a smooth uniform finish.

FINISHING BEADS AND TRIMS:

Apply three coats of compound. Apply the first coat to all the bead and trim; properly feather out onto the panel. Wet sand, as necessary. After allowing the compound to dry thoroughly, apply a second coat and feather at least 2" beyond the first coat. Allow the coat to dry completely and wet sand, if necessary. Apply the finishing coat and extend the compound slightly beyond the previous coat. Once the last coat is dry, sand if necessary to provide a smooth surface for subsequent decoration.

SANDING:

If necessary, eliminate dust and minimize scuffing the wallboard paper by first sanding with a wet sponge. Remove high spots using as few strokes as necessary. Clean the sponge frequently during use. If dry sanding is required, use 150 grit or finer sand paper. Delicately sand imperfections and be careful to avoid scuffing the paper. Wear a NIOSH approved dust mask and eye protection whenever dry sanding.

DECORATION:

Before applying decoration, make sure that all surfaces are thoroughly dry and dust free. Before applying paint, texture, or wallpaper, a good quality drywall primer or an undiluted latex wall paint with a high solids content should be on the surface to be decorated. Heed all product manufacturers' specific directions for painting and decorating materials.
